Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), Section 6(h) Policy & Declaration of Compliance

1. Purpose

This declaration confirms Logitech's compliance with the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), Section 6(h), which restricts the use of certain persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals in electronic and electrical equipment.

2. Scope

This declaration applies to all Logitech electronic and electrical equipment (EEE) and affirms that these products do not intentionally contain restricted substances under TSCA Section 6(h), as issued on January 6, 2021.

3. Declaration of Compliance

Logitech confirms that the following **PBT chemicals** are **not intentionally added** to our electronic and electrical equipment:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

4. Review and Update

This declaration is reviewed and updated as necessary to reflect regulatory changes and industry best practices. Logitech remains committed to working with suppliers, industry groups, and regulatory bodies to ensure compliance with all applicable chemical regulations.
