








They're designing spaces around people and prioritizing human connection.








MICROSOFT AZURE DIGITAL TWINS AND INTERNET OF THINGS TECHNOLOGY

This is made possible by Internet of Things (IoT) technology and Microsoft Azure Digital Twins, a platform that enables developers to create a digital replica of physical environments in real time.

Most Microsoft offices are equipped with thousands of IoT sensors typically used to monitor temperature, air quality control, and functionality of equipment. Now, Microsoft is finding new ways to use those sensors and improve the experience of its employees as they return to the office.

Thanks to Azure Digital Twins and IoT technology, Microsoft is using information from space usage and reservation information in tandem with sensor data to track building usage and save time for employees.

In medium and large spaces, a curved table like the Steelcase Ocular Arc7 table encircles the AV equipment like Rally Bar stack and faces a large, 21:9 aspect ratio display to foster more immersive connections with remote participants. For smaller rooms, a gumdrop or guitar pick-shaped table helps to achieve that same degree of face-to-face engagement, enabling interactions that feel like everyone is in the same room.


